The campus is especially interested in candidates who can contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community through their research, teaching, and/or service. Appointments are temporary positions with end dates and generally made one quarter at a time, based on the changing curriculum needs of the department.

RANK: Lecturer

SALARY: Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Estimated range of \$5,500 to \$9,000 per course.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: M.S., Ph.D. or equivalent in Applied Mathematics, Statistics, or closely related field and demonstrated potential for university teaching.

TO APPLY: Applicants should submit a letter of application which includes description of courses qualified to teach; curriculum vitae (CV), evaluations of teaching (if available); sample course materials (syllabi, handouts, etc., if available); and arrange for three confidential letters of recommendation* to be sent directly on their behalf.
