RANK: Lecturer

SALARY: Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Salary is generally in the range of \$6,126 to \$7,200 per course.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Chemistry or Biochemistry (in hand at time of appointment).

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: University teaching experience.

TO APPLY: Applications are accepted via the UCSC Academic Recruit online system, and must include a letter of application which includes description of courses qualified to teach; curriculum vitae; evaluations of teaching (if available); sample course material—syllabi, handouts, etc. (if available); and three letters of recommendation.* Documents/materials must be submitted as PDF files.
