[Porter College](#), an undergraduate, liberal arts college at the University of California, Santa Cruz (UCSC) invites applications to an on-going pool of qualified part-time temporary lecturer(s) to teach occasional courses, under the direction of the Porter College Provost. Applicants should be able to contribute to one or more of the following subject areas: Arts, Engineering, Humanities, Natural Sciences, and Social Sciences. Successful candidates will be expected to teach 2-unit or 5-unit courses in their area of expertise.

Porter College is especially dedicated to fostering achievement in the arts and humanities, and candidates with experience in art history, creative writing, dance, environmental art, film and video, literature, philosophy of art, photography, theater arts, and visual art will be preferred. Applications concerning studio and theoretical approaches to the arts (including handicraft), interdisciplinary work involving the arts or humanities, and the impact of the arts or humanities in the public sphere are particularly welcome.

**RANK:** Lecturer

**SALARY:** Commensurate with qualifications, experience, and number of course units taught per quarter.

**BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:** Master's Degree; or two years of artistic and creative work, consisting of publications, performances, exhibitions, or installations; or two years of scholarship published in print or web-based media.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** College level teaching experience and experience teaching first-year university students is desirable.

**POSITION AVAILABLE:** As openings occur, contingent upon availability of funding.

**TO APPLY:** Applications are accepted via the UCSC Academic Recruit online system, and must include a brief cover letter, an up-to-date curriculum vitae, complete syllabi for at least one and no more than three courses, three current letters of recommendation\*, and, if available, teaching evaluations for a course taught within the past three years.
