



[Oakes College](#) at the University of California, Santa Cruz (UCSC) invites applications for an on-going pool of qualified part-time temporary lecturers to teach occasional seminar-style “college enhancement” courses under the direction of the Oakes College Provost. Enhancement courses should contribute to the college’s longstanding interests, which are ethnic studies and the sciences from a social justice-related framework. Applicants should be able to draw from expertise in one or several of the major disciplinary subject areas (Arts, Engineering, Humanities, Physical and Biological Sciences, and Social Sciences). We are especially interested in applicants with professional experience in social justice or public service organizations.

For instructors intending to propose potential course offerings, seminars that focus on social justice are strongly encouraged.

Regular appointments are during the academic year, but accepted candidates will also be eligible for Summer Session appointments, should they be available.

**RANK:** Lecturer

**SALARY:** Commensurate with qualifications, experience, and number of course units taught per quarter. Compensation for Summer Session courses may vary from courses taught during the academic year.

**BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Master’s degree
- Experience providing instruction in an educational environment

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Terminal degree
- Teaching experience (i.e., the instructor of record) in higher education

**POSITION AVAILABLE:** As openings occur, appointments contingent upon availability of funding.

**TO APPLY:** Applications are accepted via the UCSC Academic Recruit online system, and must include a letter of application which includes a description of courses you are qualified to teach; curriculum vitae; a statement describing your teaching philosophy; and three confidential letters of recommendation (a minimum of two are required and a maximum of three will be accepted)\*. Applicants may also submit evaluations of teaching (a maximum of three will be accepted); sample course materials - syllabi, handouts, etc. (a maximum of three will be accepted). Documents/materials must be submitted as PDF files.
