Re: 2010-11 Academic Salary Scales

The Academic Salary Scales have been updated for 2010-11. While most salary scales remain the same, changes have been made to the Academic Student Employee and Postdoctoral Scholar Salary Scales.

Academic Student Employees: In accordance with the contractual agreement between the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America (UAW) and the University of California, the salary rates for the Academic Student Employee (ASE) unit have been range adjusted by an across-the-board increase of two percent effective February 1, 2011.

Postdoctoral Scholars: The UAW is now the exclusive representative of the UC Postdoctoral Scholars, and a five-year contract has been negotiated. In accordance with this contract, beginning June 1, 2011, minimum salary/stipend rates for postdoctoral scholars shall be based on the National Institutes of Health (NIH) experience-based steps (see <u>NIH Notice pertaining to the Ruth L.</u> <u>Kirschstein National Research Service Award (NRSA) Stipend Levels</u>). Until June 1, 2011, departments and divisions may continue to use the Postdoctoral Scholar Standard Table of Pay Rates as a guideline for calculating compensation for postdoctoral scholars.
