Re: Update to CAPM – Term of Appointment at Step 9 and Above-Scale for Professional Researchers

Dear Colleagues:

I write to inform you of an update to the campus academic personnel policy involving the Professional Research Series (<u>CAPM 600.310</u>), which brings the allowable term of appointment at Step 9 and Above-Scale into alignment with eligibility for advancement.

Prior to this change, the maximum term of appointment in this series was three years. However, academic policy states that advancement from Step 9 to Above-Scale, and advancement within Above-Scale, will not occur after less than four years at step (or salary). With this change, appointments and reappointments made at Step 9 and Above-Scale may now be granted for up to a maximum of four years, which means that the appointment and/or reappointment terms and normal advancement eligibility may now be set up to coincide. This change does not impact the <u>Delegation of Authority</u> for this series.

Of course, appointments may still be made at fewer than four years at these particular junctures; the intent here is to provide greater flexibility to maximize the time and efforts of all involved in these personnel actions.
